

RE: 2019 ATP CHALLENGER TOUR — SUMMARY OF CHANGES

Please pay attention to the following important changes to the ATP Challenger Tour, effective 1st January 2019.

1. ATP Challenger Tour Categories / Points / Prize Money

The ATP Challenger Tour events will be re-named according to points awarded to the winner of the event. There will continue to be five categories of events.

- o ATP Challenger 125
- o ATP Challenger 110
- ATP Challenger 100
- ATP Challenger 90
- ATP Challenger 80

For the points and prize money breakdown per round, please see Exhibit A.

2. Tournament Week & Draw Format

All Challenger events will be played over seven (7) days, starting Monday and finishing on Sunday, with the following format:

- o Main Draw: 48 players
- o Doubles: 16 teams (no Qualifying event)
- o Singles Qualifying event with 4 players only

3. Hospitality

All ATP Challenger Tour events must provide Hospitality.

- o Singles players: starting Saturday through the night of their last match with no minimum number of nights
- o Doubles players: starting Sunday through the night of their last match with no minimum number of nights
- Qualifiers:Only players who qualify for the main draw receive hospitality (backdated to Saturday)

• Players who do not book by the two-week deadline will not have hospitality guaranteed.

4. Special Schedule

ATP Challenger Tour events held in the week prior to a Grand Slam event in the same region may apply for a Sunday to Saturday schedule.

5. Alternative Format Based on Tournament Request

Tournaments may apply to hold at 56 Draw Singles Event with the following format

o Main Draw: 56 players

o Doubles: 16 teams (no Qualifying event).

o Qualifying: 4 players

ATP approval will be based upon but not limited to, these factors:

o Calendar position

- Adequacy of facility
- o Match Schedule Plan
- Location
- o Any other factor deemed relevant by ATP

Total financial commitment (prize money and fee) for 56 draw tournaments will be the same as for a 48 draw.
